Competition

Three Act

This competition is a great opportunity for members to showcase their creative abilities and drama skills. Competitors are required to rehearse and perform a Three Act play for entry in the competition. Each Club must organise a public performance and invite an adjudicator, provided by the CEO to attend.

The Three Act Drama Festival is open to members between the ages of 12 and 30 who hold a valid YFCU membership. Clubs may also enter up to three paid members up to the age of 40. Only teams which operate under the name and auspices of a Young Farmers' Club are eligible to compete. A copy of the Play must reach YFCU HQ by the date specified. A license to perform must be obtained by each competing team. Written evidence must be provided before the performance, if required. Only one change of date or venue will be permitted. Anything in excess of this will cancel entry and result in the Club losing their entry fee.

An adjudicator will attend and assess each performance, taking into account the following aspects:

Proficiencies of merit are awarded to all the cast and a maximum of 10 backstage. Appoint one person in the Club who will be responsible for the

Club members' behaviour during the festival. They will be responsible for vacating the dressing room, ensuring it is left in proper order and condition.

If required correspondence can be passed on to someone directly concerned with the play. YFCU encourages two clubs to amalgamate if they have insufficient members taking part.

Prizes:

A competition cup (to be held for I year) will be awarded to the Club gaining the highest number of marks. In addition, a variety of awards will be made as follows:

- Most Promising Actor
- Most Promising Actress
- Best Set
- Certificates of Merit for Acting
- Certificate of Merit for Production
