Competition Silage Assessment

Competitors are required to visually assess two silage samples and give a written assessment of the silage. All written assessments must be handed in to the designated steward once completed.

Heats for the silage assessment competition normally occur on the same evening as the Dairy Stock Judging heats. Each area will be subdivided, and members will compete in their respective age groups. Finals will take place on the same evening as the Stock Judging Finals. Members will be given a short introduction to visually assessing silage before competing.

Eligibility

The silage assessment competition is open to all members between the ages of 11 – 30, who hold a valid YFCU membership.

Competitors will be given 10 minutes to assess two silage samples through digestibility, dry matter and pH. The closing date for entries will be provided by YFCU HQ.

Proficiencies

Proficiencies will be awarded on marks gained at the competition.

Prizes

Each age group receives a plaque and certificate for first place and a certificate for second and third place.

Discipline

Clubs must appoint one person to be responsible for their members' behaviour.
